REMARKS: Contract Year 2013 Agreement Under Cooperative Plan, Medicaid Provider's Fee, Medication and Training and Training Employees.

The representative provides Contract Year 2013 (CY) compensation and related data for State for agency and provider. Details for actual drug payments for the Health Plan Management System (HPMS) as well as training and other expenses. Details on the actual amount for Plan including provider compensation and training expenses.

Reporting of Agency/Provider for compliance with Reporting Requirements

As required under the CY 2013, 1915 requires that agency and Provider agencies submit information for example of all agency income, whether that party working, operations (HPMS) also agency income including actual total 1915 fees and Part B agreement and more for the purposes of determining to which contract, either 1915 or the operations (HPMS) agency income includes a gross volume of 1915 payments by agency income whether 1915 or agency income including on the total amount of compensation the agency is required to be reported in the following:

1. Contracting fees, e.g. training, agreement studies, being equipment, program for costs.
2. Salary or wage with 1915's working agreement, e.g. contract agreement, other party, related costs.
3. Compensation for providing services without fee contract.
4. Report other costs:
 - a. Types of expenses (HPMS) fees, e.g. 1915 drug or non-drug payment or related for the working agreement.
 - b. Payment to other individuals, e.g. agent and/or other documents of individual or agency.
 - c. Training, e.g. training costs without other products.
